This has been an impactful trip for many students in the past and many commit to returning to Fiji a second year after developing meaningful relationships with locals on previous trips. This year, the students going on the trip are trying to raise a significant amount of money: \$55,000. This covers their travel cost, food, medical and building supplies. **So far, the student's have raised \$32,000 of this amount and are still in need of \$23,000.**
