7) PAA as in years past, we have 20 students and three sponsors embarking on a mission trip to Fiji with the Jabez Humanitarian Foundation. Not only will students lend their physical skills to building a new structure for the Jabez organization, but they will be learning about Fiji's deeper cultural needs by aiding in medical treatment, supervised by Dr. Hanson. This has been an impactful trip for many students in the past and many commit to returning to Fiji a second year after developing meaningful relationships with locals on previous trips. This year, the students going on the trip are trying to raise a significant amount of money: \$55,000. This covers their travel cost, food, medical and building supplies. **So far, the student's have raised \$32,000 of this amount and are still in need of \$23,000.**
